

Sathya Sai College Discipline Roadmap

1a.
Inappropriate class or playground behaviour:
 a) Teacher has chat with the student.
 b) Reminder given from the teacher.
 c) TWO reminders receives a **time-in**.

1b.
Extreme Unacceptable Behaviour
 1. Extreme unacceptable behaviour is dangerous and hurtful and results in others feeling unsafe, hurt, scared, e.g. punching, swearing, weapons, tantrums, throwing/pushing furniture, Bullying, cyberbullying
 2. Straight to Principal or Wellbeing Coordinator

2.
Time in:
 a) Student returns to teacher for 10 minutes at the next break.
 b) Time-in will be recorded on Sentral.
 c) THREE time-ins will result in a reflection.

3.
Reflection:
 a) Behaviour recorded on Sentral and student sees the Wellbeing Coordinator at lunch.
 b) WC and student discuss what happened and strategies on how to fix it and to avoid it happening again.
 c) Student completes reflection sheet.
 d) WC sends letter home to be signed and returned.

4.
TWO Reflections:
 a) Student placed on Behaviour Support Plan (BSP).
 b) Positive Monitoring Card for 2 weeks
 c) If behaviour continues, teacher and WC will review BSP.
 d) If the student receives another reflection while on BSP, they will face a Short Suspension (up to 4 school days).
 e) This may be in or out of school (decided by Principal/Wellbeing Coordinator).

5.
Behaviour Continues:
 a) Long suspension (5 to 20 school days)
 b) Re-entry to school negotiated with parents, Principal and Wellbeing Coordinator.

6.
Behaviour Continues:
 a) Termination of enrolment.
 b) Termination of enrolment would be considered in context of previous behaviour and seriousness of event.

Student Code of Conduct

Love

- Do not distract others. Give every other student the opportunity to learn.
- Respect your property and that of others, including the school.
- Value the interests, abilities and cultures of all others in the school community.
- Develop an attitude of selfless service to the community.

Peace

- Be at the right place, at the right time, with the right equipment.
