#### 1a.

#### Inappropriate class or playground behaviour:

- a) Teacher has chat with the student.
- b) Reminder given by the teacher.
- c) Three reminders in the session receives a time-in.
- d) A 4th reminder in the session receives a reflection.
- e) Student may work off reminders with positive behaviour.

#### 1b.

#### **Extreme Unacceptable Behaviour**

- 1. Extreme unacceptable behaviour is dangerous and hurtful and results in others feeling unsafe, hurt, scared, e.g. punching, swearing, weapons, tantrums, throwing/pushing furniture, drugs.
- 2. Straight to Deputy Principal or Wellbeing Coordinator

## Time in:

a) Student returns to teacher for 10 minutes at the

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- b) Time-in will be recorded on Sentral.
- c) Four time-ins in a term will result in an instant reflection.

## K 3.

#### Reflection:

- a) Behaviour recorded on Sentral and student sees the Wellbeing Coordinator at lunch.
- b) Wellbeing Coordinator and student discuss incident and strategies for moving forward.
- c) Student completes reflection sheet.
- d) Wellbeing Coordinator emails reflection letter home.

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#### Two Reflections in a term:

- a) Wellbeing Coordinator or Deputy Principal inform parents.
- b) Wellbeing Coordinator and teacher develop Behaviour Support Plan
- c) If behaviour continues, teacher and/or Wellbeing Coordinator will
- d) If the student receives another reflection while on their BSP, they will face a Short Suspension (Max. 5 school days).
- e) This may be in or out of school (decided by Deputy Principal/Wellbeing

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### 5.

#### **Behaviour Continues:**

- a) Long suspension (6-20 days)
- b) Re-entry to school negotiated with parents, Deputy Principal and Wellbeing Coordinator.



- a) Behaviour continues.
- b) Termination of enrolment would be considered in context of previous behaviour and seriousness of event.
